**Drop Opposition**

Dear Assemblymember Berman et al,

I am writing to you on behalf of the Peace and Freedom Party of California to drop our opposition to AB 1829, as it is being amended to eliminate Section 9 of the bill.

Section 9 of AB 1829 would have changed the mailing requirement for candidate endorsement letters from a simple letter from the party chair to each of the 58 counties election officials, where the candidate will appear on the ballot, to a certified letter from the party chair. With the removal of this unnecessary change from the bill Peace and Freedom Party is dropping our opposition.
