I am writing to you on behalf of Peace and Freedom Party of California which first qualified for the ballot over 50 years ago in January 1968. Since our beginning, we have advocated that the rich and their corporations pay their fair share. Our campaign posters in 1970 read "Tax the Rich". So, of course we support AB 1253.

While Peace and Freedom Party supports AB 1253, we noticed that these additional taxes are based on adjusted gross incomes which are higher than actual incomes. We also noticed that the additional taxes are separate from the regular tax brackets and do not account for the different types of filers. We question why these new tax rates are not just added beyond the current top rates.

Please, vote yes on AB 1253.
