Dear Assemblymember Wilson:

I am writing to you on behalf of the Peace and Freedom Party of California in support of ACA 8 (Wilson).

ACA 8 simply abolishes all forms of slavery, without exception. No longer could forced labor be used as a punishment. Even if we would vote for or against a bill in the legislature, we usually refrain from taking a position on issues, unless we can show how our analysis is different from those of the two dominant parties, we have been asked to take a position by an organization we work with, or our position helps pass or defeat a bill. However, because any form of slavery is so abhorrent and should have never been allowed, we decided it was important to add our name to support this constitutional amendment.
